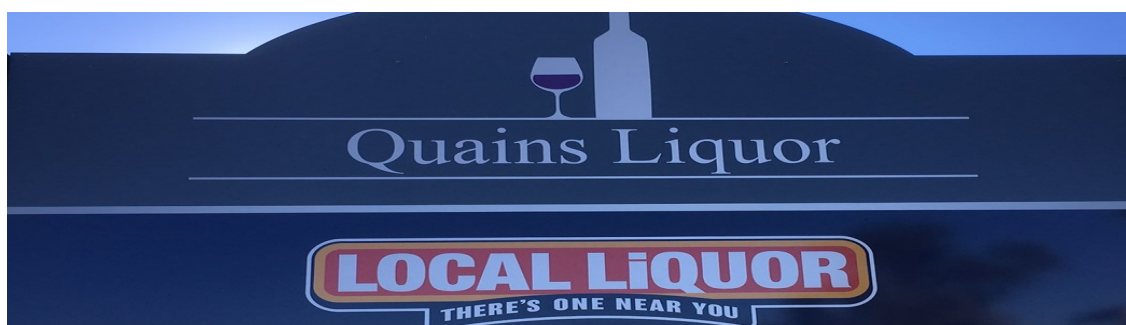

## **EXTRACTS FROM AN ARTICLE WHICH APPEARED IN THE SYDNEY MORNING HERALD**

This article was provided to me by John Southwell and is well worth remembering:-

“**The Masters** At a time when the sporting conversation has been dominated by cheating, what perfect timing for the showpiece event of humankind's most ethical professional sport. If there is a spectrum of sporting morality that has cycling, pro boxing and power lifting down at one end, golf is the opposite. This is the game where players call penalties on themselves and referees are seldom seen and never heard. It is also a constant reminder that money doesn't necessarily ruin sportsmanship (sic). In fact, all the derision for overpaid, pampered, self-obsessed, over-managed professionals goes out the window when you talk about golf. Why? One word (sorry): culture .The game has a culture of mutual respect. Even Tiger Woods, who at times looked like he was flying free of those cultural constraints, has been humbled by golf, forgiven, and brought back into the fold.”
